3 Pray Together

Invite the Holy Spirit into the moment and declare God's power over addiction.

(James 5:16b)

4 Refer to S2L Recovery

Christ-centered, clinically excellent recovery for men. Not just a referral, a partnership.

(John 8:36)

5 Follow Up

Stay connected. Encourage, pray, and walk alongside them during and after recovery.

(Galatians 6:2)
